Baghima, Chhattisgarh, India

My first story is about a very small village named Baghima in Chhattisgarh, India, where we were having a washroom constructed for children when Covid arrived and the world just stopped.

During Covid and the lockdowns that followed, people were not allowed to go to work and had no money to buy food. This made me very sad and I knew *Children are Angels from Heaven* had to reach out in some way to help the people.

It took a little time, but with the help of many people, our funds arrived for Sis-



ter Mary in the village; and she was able to help ten families in a time of great need, as well as keeping everyone safe from Covid.

Sister Mary, and the other Daughters of the



Cross Sisters, did a wonderful job gathering many needed basic food items and distributing them to the people in need. The finished project was successful, and many families were helped and were very thankful for our help. Without **your** help and support to *Children are Angels from Heaven* this project would have never happened.



Covid Relief for Kolkata

I have always looked after every single penny of people's hard earned, donated money sent to *Children are Angels from Heaven*, no matter what the project is.

Kolkata was in great need of aid from Covid and I wanted to step forward to help. They helped many people in Kolkata during this time of need. Covid Relief for a Fishing Village in India

My friend, Dibyendu, and his club, the New Alipore (Eastern) Club of New Alipore in Kolkata, have been reaching out to help a fishing village about 100 miles from Kolkata, on the coast of the Bay of Bengal. This village was hit by a cyclone as well as Covid. Dibyendu distributed face masks given to him by *Children are Angels from Heaven* as well as many women's sarees given to the club. It was a wonderful project during a great time of need for the people. Below you can read his mail to me and see the photos he sent.

"We had to defer our relief program by a day due to heavy rain.

We did our program on Sunday and Monday at two places on an island in the Bay of Bengal which suffered very heavy loss of properties in the cyclone 'Yaas' which struck the Bengal coast on 25th May. This particular island is the home of three hundred thousand people, homes of about thirty thousand, have been washed away. We distributed 300 sarees (Ethnic wear of Bengali ladies), rice and pulses¹. We got the right opportunity to distribute the left over masks sent by you at these places.

Four weeks after the debacle, people are still in tents and dependent on NGOs and government relief for food and other necessities.

¹ Pulses have a long history, with records of their consumption in the Middle East over 11,000 years ago by some of the earliest human civilizations. Fast-forward to 2016: The United Nations declared it was the International Year of Pulses, with a mission to get people around the world to eat more of the edible seeds. Why? These superfoods are nutritious, inexpensive and beneficial to the environment.



Covid Relief for Rourkela, India

I think for this Covid relief story it is best to let you read the report sent to me by the head Sister in Rourkela, Sister Anupama. *Children are Angels from Heaven* sent the funds to the Convent in Rourkela, India to fund the project and Sister Anupama as well as all the Daughters of the Cross Sisters did the work to buy, sort, and distribute food to people in need during very bad Covid times. The Sisters did a fantastic job with this project and worked very hard to look after everyone.

Our hearts are filled with gratitude for your generosity in helping the needy at this difficult moment. Your generosity means a lot to us and to our helpless and hopeless people. God has visited us through you. I give you a report of our distribution which you can see following.

We purchased: - Rice, dall, potatoes, flower, sugar, onion, garlic, flat rice, milk powder, spices, papad, jagry, biscuits, and sanitizer. We packed them for the families for the distribution.

The families, who could come to our place, came to collect the packets. The next picture is a handicapped person, who goes around in a wheelchair came to us for the food grain.

All the families are struggling to survive. They have no jobs. Due to Corona no work is available. They are very grateful to get these grains. All those who could not come, we reached the families with the food.














They live in our locality, in our slums, some of them work in the field, or in construction work. Since there is lock down, people have no jobs and are struggling to


If it was not for the help and support of many people who support *Children are Angels from Heaven*, this emergency donation project would have never happened.


In Closing
